2022 RUN WOODSTOCK CAMPING

There are no bad choices when it comes to the Run Woodstock Camp areas, each offer a unique flair and will develop their own vibe. Bring your creative hippy theme additions, you can a magical difference!

Black dots on the site map denote trees. Sites with trees, by using a creative lay out, all have room for a car and tent, perhaps not a good choices for trailers/campers but trees can be cool for hammocs, clothes lines and add natural beauty!

T squares denote a latrine, and F squares show where the main fire pits are.

There are no electric or water hookups at Run Woodstock. We will have charging stations and water pumps close to each camping area. There is a heated shower building near the front of camp that has a flush bathhouse. All camping areas have latrines and port O-johns. Campers and trailers are welcome at Run Woodstock (under 30') but no hook ups, dup or fill station.

Most sites are approximately 15'x30'. The sites in Astral Plane are appx. 15"x36" perhaps a better choice for longer trailers. The far east end of Astral Plane runs into the Ultra Aid station area, making these sites a good choice for those of you running long.


Love In and Secret Circle, are close to the showers, actual flush toilets, and the beach.



Strawberry Fields is host to live music and an all night finish line, great for those who love a constant party. Area is fairly tightly packed!


START/FINISH MAIN STAGE



Astral Plane! The largest camping area at Run Woodstock! Sites and roads are slightly larger and despite how many sites there are, plenty of room!


Astral plane is directly touching the main ultra aid station, so a great choice for those coming to crew for a 100 Mile/K runner.

Just a quick walk to the start/finish area and all of the action.






Sites 256-259 while slightly slanted, are straight and larger sites - good for a camper!




Meadow offers a quiet, true wilderness camping experience. Would be great for a group looking for some quiet to escape all of the action.






Hilltop and fairyland are just off Strawberry Field, with paths connecting you to the music, finish line and fun, without having to be right in the middle of it all.
